Personal Character Reference Requirements

Your personal character letter can be written by a coach, a school counselor, a teacher, a supervisor or a mentor. When choosing someone to write your letter, you should consider people who know you well enough to provide realistic feedback for your letter. Please DO NOT USE A FAMILY MEMBER.

Your personal character letter should include answers to the following questions:

- How long have you known this student?
- What can you tell me about this student's personality?
- What can you tell me about this student's work ethic?
- How does he/she handle stress, conflict and pressure?
- How would you describe his/her communication and listening skills?
- What are some examples of his/her strengths, intellectual interests, integrity, or leadership ability?
- How do you think this student interacts with others (co-workers, customers, teachers or peers)?
- What qualities or characteristics does he or she display that will make them a great teacher candidate?
